Pupil Premium

Lateral Flow Tests

Staff at school all, have the opportunity to test for the Covid virus, twice a week using lateral flow tests. These tests are designed to pick up asymptomatic people and if a positive result is detected staff then, would have to self-isolate and get a Polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test. After this result they would either self-isolate due to having the virus or return to work if the PCR test was negative.

The lateral flow tests are the tests that secondary school children also have the opportunity to use and then many work places are providing for their staff. Lateral Flow tests are not suitable for **primary aged children** and should not be used. If your child, or anyone in your household, has symptoms of Covid 19, they should immediately self isolate and book a PCR test.

If your child is displaying symptoms of Covid 19 we will ask for them to have a PCR test and self-isolate until we know the results or they will need to selfisolate for ten days, if they do not get tested. We will send out the home learning but if your child is ill or a parent is poorly, we will not expect all the work to be completed. Your child's class teacher will be in touch, to check if there is anything you need.




Goodbyes






Our Reading dogs Monty and Star have started coming back into school too. They were a little bit nervous, but they loved seeing the children.







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
